Supervisor Derry Facilitates Day of Community Service at Yucaipa Regional Park

Brings together Cal State Greek Community and San Bernardino County Regional Parks Department

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – On Saturday, May 9th, the California State University San Bernardino Greek Community will team up with the San Bernardino County Regional Parks Department to spruce up Yucaipa Regional Park in time for its annual Memorial Day opening.

The all-day event sponsored by Supervisor Neil Derry will begin at 9a.m. It is expected to draw 100-150 students who will plant trees and bushes, paint park structures, abate weeds and assist in other general maintenance.

“Regional parks are a safe, clean option for residents looking for inexpensive family friendly activities in these tough economic times,” Supervisor Neil Derry said.

Each year the Cal State Greek Community participates in a “Unity Day” where members of various fraternities and sororities join together in a day of service. Instead of doing several smaller projects, Field Representative Nick Calero organized the large volunteer project at the park.

“This project will showcase what a phenomenal asset the Greek Community is to our region,” Calero said.

“I am looking forward to developing a strong, recurring partnership with the Greek Community in the coming years,” Supervisor Derry stated.

Supervisor Derry and Mr. Calero are both Cal State San Bernardino alumni and members of the Tau Kappa Epsilon and Sigma Chi fraternities, respectively.
