- Incurring any charges against the credit of the other party.
- Both parties are restrained from cashing, borrowing against, cancelling, transferring, disposing of, or changing the beneficiaries of any insurance or other coverage including life, health, automobile, and disability held for the benefit of the parties of their minor children.
- RESIDENCE EXCLUSION: _____ is ordered to move out and not return to the family dwelling located at _____ .
