Pursuant to California Rules of Court 10.620, the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, hereby gives notice that it will discontinue hearing matters in its Redlands Courthouse commencing October 13, 2009.

Effective October 13, 2009, all filings for Probate matters will be accepted by the Probate Division of the Clerk's office located at 303 West Third Street, San Bernardino, California. Probate matters shall thereafter be heard in the Probate Departments which will then be located in the San Bernardino District, Civil Division located at 303 West Third Street, San Bernardino, California.

Effective October 13, 2009, all Redlands filings for traffic matters will be accepted at 351 North Arrowhead, San Bernardino, California. Traffic and any other arraignments matters shall thereafter be heard at the San Bernardino District, Central Division located at 351 North Arrowhead Avenue, San Bernardino, California

The Clerk's offices are open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., except for court holidays and the third Wednesday of each month.

The decision to discontinue services in the Redlands courthouse was made by Presiding Judge James C. McGuire.

During the public comment period the court received one e-mail response and no other written or verbal responses. The response received by the court objected to the closure of the courthouse indicating that it would be a "horrible inconvenience for the elderly" and that it was a "bad idea".

There are no written factual materials that have been specifically gathered or prepared for review at the time of making the decision to terminate operations at the Redlands Courthouse.
