

## **Stater Bros. Donates \$20,000 to CAPSBC Food Bank**

**SAN BERNARDINO, CA (JULY 28, 2010)** - **Stater Bros.** presented a check for \$20,000 to **Community Action Partnership of San Bernardino (CAPSBC) Food Bank** at meeting of the Board of Directors on Tuesday, July 21, 2010. Stater Bros. has generously supported the CAPSBC Food bank since 1988.

Our food network operations are serving over 16,000 households per month because of partners like Stater Bros."
