CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR APPOINTS SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY DA TO POST LEADERSHIP TEAM

SAN BERNARDINO, Calif. – Governor Jerry Brown today appointed San Bernardino County District Attorney Michael A. Ramos to the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission (POST).

The Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training was established by the Legislature in 1959 to set minimum selection and training standards for California law enforcement.
