

All presentations must:

1. Address behavioral health or related topic and should emphasize relevance to Latino population (children, adolescent, adult, older adult).
2. Presentation may address treatment, planning, training, administration, program development or related topic.
3. Must include at least 3 learning objectives.
4. Abstract of presentation not to exceed two pages including- title, content, and method of presentation (panel, didactic, discussion, etc.)
5. Presentation will be 2 hours in duration.

Provide the following information:

1. Presenter(s) name(s) and credentials
2. Previous experience in teaching or presenting
3. Current employment affiliation
4. Presenter(s) contact information including phone number and email.

Note 1: Selection of presentation will be made by Program committee. We will notify you by March 22nd. Presentations that are selected will require additional documentation.
