

## **MOBILEHOME PARK PROGRAM UPDATE**

On July 8, 2008 the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No 4051 which cancels the County's responsibility for enforcement of the Mobilehome Parks Act within the County.

The County has been actively involved in enforcement of State Health and Safety regulations within mobilehome parks in the unincorporated county area since 1958. Most recently, EHS had also been designated as the enforcement agency for mobilehome parks within 12 incorporated cities.

The County has determined that the costs of operating the enforcement program exceeds the revenue generated, and therefore has decided to relinquish responsibility of the program back to the State Housing and Community Development Department (HCD).

**Effective July 31, 2008**, to obtain building permits or to express concerns regarding mobilehome parks within the unincorporated County area as well as the Cities of Apple Valley, Barstow, Chino Hills, Colton, Grand Terrace, Highland, Montclair, Upland and Yucca Valley contact HCD at 3737 Main St., Suite 400 in Riverside. EHS will continue to be the enforcement agency for the mobilehome parks within the Cities of Hesperia and Yucaipa until August 29, 2008 when those respective cities will assume enforcement for mobilehome parks within their jurisdictions. The City of Rancho Cucamonga will take over enforcement of mobilehome park regulations from EHS on November 26, 2008.
