Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Joint Technical Document (JTD) amendment for the Mid Valley Sanitary Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

Mid Valley Sanitary Landfill is an approximately 498-acre existing landfill site located at 2390 North Alder Avenue in the City of Rialto in the southwest corner of San Bernardino County. On September 17, 2009, the LEA received from San Bernardino County, Solid Waste Management Division, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the Mid Valley Sanitary Landfill JTD to combine previously approved changes made from the 2009 water sprinkler system submittal and the 2009 Comprehensive Disposal Site Diversion Program (CSDSP)/Resale yard submittal. No other changes to the SWFP are under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on October 16, 2009.
