**9. PROPER COOLING METHODS ⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Complied on 4/8/2015 Violation Reference - HSC - 114000	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a large plastic container filled with cooked black beans covered tightly in the walk-in cooler, reportedly prepared five hours ago, at 74 degrees F; All potentially hazardous foods [PHF] shall be RAPIDLY cooled to 41 degrees F or below with six (6) hours [from 135 to 70 within the first two hours, then to 41 or below in four hours or less].

As six hours had not yet passed, I allowed the facility to use an ice wand to finish the cooling process.

**Violation Description:** All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.

(113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)
