On this date operator requested a reinspection to reopen open food portion of this facility.

During the reinspection facility was observed with an active rodent infestation that resulted in continuance of open food closure and closure of prepackaged market.

The permit for this facility is now suspended all food and drinks can not be sold to the public until EHS verifies compliance.

-Observed several cookie packages to be bitten/ gnawed into and cookie boxes containing rodent droppings.

One power crunch chocolate mint bars

Two chips ahoy 8oz packets

Two tiger silk original bars

Two peanut butter cliff bar

One soft batch keebler chocolate chip cookie

Two keebler vanilla sugar wafers

One keebler Strawberry sugar wafer

Three cheez-it packages

One large rice krispie bar

-Observed approximately 2-3 rodent droppings on the chip rack and 2 on the parallel rack.

-Observed 80-100 rodent dropping all throughout the back storage room.

-Observed approximate 30-35 fresh rodent droppings on candy bottom shelf.

- Observed approximately 20-30 fresh rodent dropings on the beverage shelves across the 5, 6, 7, 8 beverage doors.

Facility must be free of vermin and vermin evidence at all times.

This violation results in a closure.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
