Inspector Comments: This reinspection was requested by this food facility manager. The reinspection was conducted to determine compliance from routine inspection.

This facility closed for business due to a live cockroach infestation.

On this date, after a thorough inspection of the entire kitchen, dining, and restroom area, one (1) barely live nymph cockroach was observed underneath the single door reach-in freezer next to the sliding door beverage refrigerator in the kitchen.

The manager provided the recent professional exterminator service invoices on Thursday, 12/06/2018 and Friday, 12/07/2018.

The professional exterminator, Dynamic Pest Solutions, treated with baits, powders, and pellets.

The first treatment started on Wednesday, 12/05/2018, and three follow-ups performed on Thursday, 12/06/2018 and Friday, 12/07/2018.

And two more follow-up services scheduled on Friday, 12/07/2018 and Saturday, 12/08/2018 per pest control service invoices.

Due to actively control this live cockroach infestation by the employees and the professional exterminator, The health permit for this facility was reinstated on this date.

The notice of closure sign was removed on this date.

Continue to eliminate all evidence of vermin from this food facility. Ensure to take appropriate pest control measures to eliminate all evidence of past or current vermin from this facility including but not limited to cockroaches. Clean and sanitize affected area in an approved manner.

A week follow-up inspection will be conducted on Tuesday, 11/11/2018 to determine compliance.

Any sign/ evidences of past or current vermin infestation (Ex: Any cockroaches in kitchen and dining area will result in facility closure/ permit suspension).

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

Inspector Comments: This reinspection was requested by the manager of this facility.

The health permit for this facility suspended on Wednesday, 12/05/2018 due to numerous live adult and nymph cockroaches were observed in this food facility during a routine inspection.

On this date, after thorough inspection, one (1) barely live nymph cockroach was observed on the floor underneath single door reach-in freezer next to the beverage sliding door refrigerator in the kitchen. Eliminate all evidence of vermin from this food facility. Ensure to take appropriate pest control measures to eliminate all evidence of past or current vermin from this facility including but not limited to cockroaches. Clean and sanitize affected area in an approved manner.

The manager was able to provide the most recent pest control service invoice dated on 12/06/2018 and 12/07/2018. The manager stated the first treatment was performed on 12/05/2018 afternoon. all floors, walls, and ceilings including affected areas were cleaned and sanitized at the time of this inspection. This facility was actively treated by professional exterminator twice a day since this facility was closed and suspended. Per pest control service invoices, the exterminator was not observed any cockroaches on Thursday, 12/06/2018, morning and evening and on Friday, 12/07/2018, morning.

A week follow-up inspection will be conducted on Tuesday, 12/11/2018 to determine compliance. Any sign/ evidences of past or current vermin infestation (Ex: Any cockroaches in kitchen and dining area will result in facility closure/ permit suspension).

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Inspector Comments: Observed one (1) barely alive nymph cockroach on the floor underneath single door reach-in freezer next to the beverage display refrigerator in the kitchen.

Eliminate all evidence of vermin from this food facility. Ensure to take appropriate pest control measures to eliminate all evidence of past or current vermin from this facility including but not limited to cockroaches. Clean and sanitize affected area in an approved manner.

The manager stated and provided three pest control report that the professional exterminator treated this facility on Thursday, 12/06/2018 at 5 am and at 4:06 pm, and on Friday, 12/07/2018 at 05:30 am. These are the follow up services. The manager stated the first treatment was performed on Wednesday, 12/05/2018 afternoon by the professional exterminator. Also, Two more follow services were scheduled on Friday, 12/07/2018 at 6 pm and the next day, Saturday per the pest control invoices.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

This is follow-up inspection to determine compliance of live cockroaches infestation.

Notice of Closure sign was removed.
A letter grade "C" was posted at the front window next to the entrance.

A week follow-up inspection is scheduled on Tuesday, 11/11/2018.
