Inspector Comments: Our department received a complaint from a complainant who stated that he was at the gas station and when he was walking out a rat fell on his shoulders. The management is already aware of the incident. The manager on duty, Mario, stated that there was a homeless man whom they refused to use their restroom. He stated that as the man was walking out of the building, he dropped a mouse that he claimed was from their facility. He added that when they wanted to kill the mouse, the homeless man prevented them from killing the mouse. The manager stated that the homeless man called on his 'wife', who was waiting outside the building, who came to pick up the mouse. The manager added that they later called the police to report the incident.

At the time of inspection, no mouse droppings or any activities of mice/ rodents observed in the facility.
