Met with the person in charge who stated that the fire happened on Saturday @ 11:00AM as workers were working on the roof of the facility and water started dripping from the hood on the back electrical panel attached to the pizza oven and caught fire , they used the fire extinguisher . The fire department came in and found the fire already was taken care off . NO sprinkler system turned on . The facility owner threw all exposed pizzas and cleaned the whole area . Facility was closed for 2 hours to clean up. Observed all the equipment working properly . NO further action is required.
