Overall Inspection Comments

Provide a hand wash sink with necessary supplies in wall mounted dispensers at all hand wash sinks. Paper towels need to be dispensed from a touch less type dispenser.

Facility is missing a hand wash sink in the decontamination area. Provide a hand wash sink or go to 100% prepackaged sterile supplies to continue operation presently at this facility.

Provide an Infection Prevention and Control Plan to EHS and have one available onsite.

Jesse Garcia is prohibited from operating until his registration is applied for and approved by San Bernardino County Environmental Health.

Discussed requirement for artist to include records on release form to include description of who performed work what was used and trace requirements of instruments used including lot number sterilized load etc.

Reinspection is required and fees for the re-inspection is printed on report.

Items required to comply are records: 1 sterile prepackaged instrument to operate between now and the next inspection. 2 Infection Prevention and Control Plan 3 Hand wash sink for decontamination area 4 Provide supplies in wall mounted dispensers at all hand wash sinks.
