7: Proper hot and cold holding temperatures

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

Inspector Comments: Observed Hot dogs, other items on display at 45-48 degrees F; Must maintain all PHF at 41 or below - Do Not fill display unit beyond fill line or block circulation.

14: Food contact surfaces: clean and sanitized

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

Inspector Comments: Observed staff is cleaning out the inside of the band saws every night; The band saws must be wiped out and sanitized a minimum of every four (4) hours, like any other foodprp item.

33: Nonfood-contact surfaces clean

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

Inspector Comments: Observed some dry meat splash on the container storage shelves in the meat prep area; Clean shelves and maintain clean.

34: Warewashing facilities: installed, maintained, use

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

Inspector Comments: Observed too high a concentration of sanitizer from the dispenser in the Warewash area; Recalibrate as needed and use test strips to check the concentration daily.

45: Floors, walls and ceilings: built, maintained, and

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

Inspector Comments: Observed floor has ponding water in the Meat Dept Storeroom; Keep floor dry.
 Observed wall in the Meat Dept Storeroom is coated with dry splash; Clean and maintain clean.

47: Signs posted; last inspection report available

POINTS Compliance date not specified *Violation Description:* Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
