<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))  <i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed raw shell eggs, multiple containers of cut vegetables, and pancake batter all with an internal temperature between 44-46 degrees F within the small reach in refrigeration unit in the kitchen. Maintain all PHF at or below 41 degrees F or at or above 135 degrees F at all times.

**34: Warewashing facilities: installed, maintained, use**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.  <i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed the use of an unapproved scoop to dispense bulk food items. Discontinue this practice and only use approved scoops for this task.
