POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. (113947-113947.1)

Inspector Comments: Missing manager's certificate. Obtain valid manager's certification within 60 days.

6: Adequate handwashing facilities supplied & accessi

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

Inspector Comments: Observed towels inside of the handwash sink. Handwash sink shall be used for handwashing only.

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

Inspector Comments: Observed approximately 10 containers of cream cheese holding at 54F. Discontinue holding potentially hazardous food at unapproved temperatures. Operator rapidly cooled the cream cheese.

8: Time as a public health control; procedures & reco

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> When time only, rather than time and temperature is used as a public health control, records and documentation must be maintained. Food must be marked or otherwise identified as to what time the food was removed from temperature control. (114000) Food items shall not exceed the time marked. (114000)

Inspector Comments: Observed cheese omelets holding for 1.5hrs without any time markings. Ensure all food under time as a public health control is marked accordingly.

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

Inspector Comments: Observed pancake/waffle mix stored on the floor inside the dry storage area. Properly store all food a minimum of 6 inches off the floor on approved stands.
