8: Time as a public health control; procedures & reco

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> When time only, rather than time and temperature is used as a public health control, records and documentation must be maintained. Food must be marked or otherwise identified as to what time the food was removed from temperature control. (114000) Food items shall not exceed the time marked. (114000)

<i>Inspector Comments:</i>		
-Observed no time control stamp on several "dim sum" food products and pork buns held on steam table at front server area. Per operator, most of the foods held on steam table at front server area are controlled with time; however, there were no time control stamp/sticker on "dim sum" food products and pork buns. Foods were cooked since 10:30am.		
-Ensure all foods controlled through time are properly labeled with time control stamp/sticker (date/time made and time of discard).

7: Proper hot and cold holding temperatures

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

<i>Inspector Comments:</i>		
Observed 2 raw half-cut marinated pork held at room temperature in prep-sink. Per operator, pork is left at room temperature to marinate since 11:30am, then drained and cooked. Ensure all potentially hazardous foods are held at 41°F or below at all times for proper cold-holding.		

40: Wiping cloths: properly used and stored

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

<i>Inspector Comments:</i>		
Observed zero chlorine sanitizer level inside dirty sanitizer bucket at cook's line. Ensure sanitizer level remains at 100 ppm - 200 ppm for chlorine.		

44: Premises; personal/cleaning items; vermin-proofing

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

-Observed a personal bowl of food stored on top of sushi rice inside rice cooker at sushi area.		
-Observed a used and crumbled aluminum foil stored inside sushi rice inside rice cooker at sushi area.		
-Ensure all personal foods and items are stored in a designated area, away from foods or food contact surfaces.
