Talked to the Manager about the complaint. The Manager said that someone had complained about seeing roaches. But, she (manager) was not able to see any roaches. So, she decided to call the facility's Pest control operator (Terminex).

The PCO checked, found no roaches, but treated for roaches anyway.

The facility maintains monthly pest control service with Terminex (record on file).

The Manager has increased this service to weekly to make sure that no roaches are present in the facility.

A follow up inspection of facility will be addressed during the facility's routine inspection expected in less than 30 days.
