Violation Description: During your last routine inspection, it was noted that your facility was in violation of the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County. Since the inspection, food worker certification compliance has not been verified by Environmental Health staff. A billable reinspection has been conducted on this date to verify compliance.

Inspector Comments:

-A billable reinspection was conducted at facility regarding food handler cards that has not been received by Department of Environmental Health Services (DEHS) after 14 days, from last routine inspection conducted on 12/19/12 and 01/15/13 for a charged re-inspection.

-Upon inspection, operator stated food handler card has not been obtained and will be obtained and faxed within 7 days.

-Non-compliance will result in supervisory hearing.
