**1: Demonstration of knowledge; food safety certification**

*Violation Description:* All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. (113947-113947.1)

*Inspector Comments:* Observed no person with a food managers certificate. Ensure to obtain a valid managers certificate within 60 days and provide managers certificate on site.

**21: Hot and cold water available**

*Violation Description:* An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113953(c), 114099.2(b) 114101(a), 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)

*Inspector Comments:* Observed a maximum hot water temperature of 103°F at the mop sink and 111°F in the food prep sink. Provide a minimum hot water temperature of 120°F.

**27: Food separated and protected**

*Violation Description:* All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

*Inspector Comments:* Observed uncovered tray of meat in the walk-in cooler. Cover any open foods.

**32: Food properly labeled & honestly presented**

*Violation Description:* Any food is misbranded if its labeling is false or misleading, if it is offered for sale under the name of another food, or if it is an imitation of another food for which a definition and standard of identity has been established by regulation. (114087, 114089, 114089.1(a, b), 114090, 114093.1) Bulk food available for consumer self-service must have an information label, sign, and/or other method of notification that includes the label information. (114089) Prepackaged food must bear a label that complies with the labeling requirements as prescribed by the Sherman Food, Drug and Cosmetic Law. (114089 and 114089(a)) Restaurants must provide a brochure placed at the point of sale that includes at least calories, sodium, saturated fat, and carbohydrates information per menu item. For sit-down restaurants, the information must be provided at the table. Drive-thrus are required to have the brochures available upon request and have a notice of the availability at the point of sale. (114094)

*Inspector Comments:* Observed bags of tortilla and salsa containers for sale without label. Ensure to provide label of name and location of where tortilla chips are bagged and where salsa is prepared.

**34: Warewashing facilities: installed, maintained, used; test strips**

*Violation Description:* Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

*Inspector Comments:* Observed less than 100 ppm chlorine sanitizer in the 3 compartment sink and in the sanitizer bucket.

Use test strips to verify sanitizer concentration of 100 to 200 ppm chlorine sanitizer. Corrected to 100 ppm.

Observed plastic used as a drain plug to keep sanitizer basin full. Repair or replace drain stopper or plug.



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**Non-critical Violations**

**44: Premises; personal/cleaning items; vermin-proofing**

*Violation Description:* The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

*Inspector Comments:* Observed gap under back door.  
Provide weather stripping or other measures to prevent vermin entry.

**45: Floors, walls and ceilings: built, maintained, and clean**

**POINTS**

*Violation Description:* The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

*Inspector Comments:* Observed loose and missing base cove tiles throughout the facility.  
Repair or replace base cove tiles.

Observed holes in the walls and door entries in several locations in the facility.  
Repair holes.

Observed peeling paint and broken plaster on the ceiling of the walk-in cooler.  
Repair and repaint.

**47: Signs posted; last inspection report available**

*Violation Description:* Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406

*Inspector Comments:* Observed that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is not available.  
Keep and maintain a copy of the previous inspection report at this facility and provide a copy for review upon request.
