Violation Description: During your last routine inspection, it was noted that your facility was in violation of the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County. Since the inspection, food worker certification compliance has not been verified by Environmental Health staff. A billable reinspection has been conducted on this date to verify compliance.

Inspector Comments:

-A follow-up inspection was conducted at facility regarding 2 food worker cards that have not been submitted to Division of Environmental Health Services (DEHS) within 14 days of inspection conducted on 02/04/13.

-Upon inspection, observed the following:

- Per operator, food worker verification sheet has not been submitted to DEHS. Facility has 7 days to submit food worker verification sheet to DEHS. Non-compliance will result in future charged re-inspections at \$245.00/hour.
