POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))
	Complied on 3/12/2013	<i>Inspector Comments:</i> Measured raw fish at the preparation cold holding unit ranging from 44F - 47F. Employee immediately moved items to walk-in refrigerator.

Discontinue holding potential hazardous foods at unapproved temperature.

6: Adequate handwashing facilities supplied & accessible

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)
	Not In Compliance	<i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed front hand washing with food and towel inside. Discontinue using hand washing sink as preparation sink. Designate all hand washing sinks for the purpose of hand washing only.

18: Compliance with variance, specialized process, & HACCP Plan

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> HACCP Plan is a written document that delineates the formal procedures developed for safe food handling approved by the National Advisory Committee on Microbiological Criteria for Foods (114419). A written document approving a deviation from standard health code requirements shall be maintained at the food facility (114057, 114057.1). Food facility operator must submit for an HACCP approval or follow an approved HACCP plan.
	Not In Compliance	<i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed pH log not kept up-to-date for sushi rice; missing data from 3-7/13 to today (3/12/13). Accurately maintain daily/hourly record of pH data and follow HACCP plan accordingly.

27: Food separated and protected

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.
	Not In Compliance	<i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed raw meat sitting over a tray of cooked wonton inside the walk-in freezer. Separate all raw from cooked and ready to eat foods.

30: Food storage; food storage containers identified

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))
	Not In Compliance	<i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed a container of bulk flour on the floor in the dry storage room. Observed a container of ice cream and a box of raw fish on the floor inside the walk-in freezer.

Ensure to properly store all food at least 6 inches above the floor.

POINTS 0	Compliance date not specified	<i>Violation Description:</i> Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.
