Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. Ensure that sanitizing solutions are maintained at 100ppm for chlorine. Store wiping cloths in sanitizing solution in buckets prior to and after each use. Corrected during inspection.

 Provide thorough cleaning.

36: Equipment, utensils and linens: storage and use

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

Inspector Comments: Observed plastic cups being used as food scoops.
 Ensure that food scoops are used in place of cups.

38: Adequate ventilation and lighting; designated area

POINTS

 Not In Compliance

Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

Inspector Comments: Observed no shatter protection on the light bulb inside the walk-in freezer.
 Provide shatter protection to all light fixtures in the walk-in cold storage.

39: Thermometers provided and accurate

Violation Description: An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)

Inspector Comments: Observed no thermometers in milk and egg display refrigerators.
 Ensure that all food display refrigerators have functioning thermometers.

44: Premises; personal/cleaning items; vermin-proofing

POINTS

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

Inspector Comments: Observed openings at the floor-end of the back door large enough to pass roaches.
 Provide seal around this and other doors so as to exclude vermin from entering the facility.
