Inspector Comments: Immediately obtain a valid health permit within 72 hours, no later than 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 2, 2013. Operator is currently operating without a valid health permit due to check for health permit fees returned due to insufficient funds.

Payment must be made by cash, cashiers check or money order only. Failure to comply will result in closure of facility and other possible legal action.

Violation Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Not In Compliance

Violation Reference: HSC

Inspector Comments: Reinspection conducted this date to determine compliance regarding vermin infestation from previous inspections.

Overall Inspection Comments

Performed a thorough reinspection at facility. Observed no recent vermin activity. Observed bait stations placed outside facility and glue traps placed under equipment.
Facility has contracted with a professional pest control operator for regular pest control treatments and has been monitored 3 times this week with no activity observed, although comments notated on pest control report states that housekeeping is in fair condition.
Facility has drafted a daily cleaning and maintenance schedule for all employees.

Continue to clean and sanitize affected areas where residual mouse droppings have been observed: behind chest freezer in meat cutting room, and in southeast corner of facility under electric cord.
Continue to clean and maintain floors. Observed food debris and dirt on floors along base coving throughout facility.

Periodic reinspections will be conducted to observed continued compliance. If vermin activity is observed, the inspection(s) will be charged at a rate of \$245.00 per hour with a 1/2 hour minimum, and another Permit Suspension/Revocation Hearing will be scheduled.

Ensure to submit payment for insufficient funds for health permit no later than 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 2, 2013. Failure to comply will result in closure of facility and/or further legal action.
