This Department received a complaint stating that there are some employees that do not have food handler cards. The complaint list employees by name that do not have food handler cards. According to complaint, employees tend to run and hide when an inspector is present.

Observed missing food handler cards.  
Ensure all employees obtain valid San Bernardino County Food handler cards.  
Ensure all employees obtain valid food cards in 14 days

This Department received a complaint stating that Yangtze uses food from trash to serve to customers.  
Per management and cook line staff, food is served fresh to order.  
Observed food being prepared at time of complaint inspection.  
Observed food stored at proper temperatures at cold holding units.

This Department received a complaint stating that Yangtze is not kept clean.  
Observed establishment in good condition.  
Ensure hard to reach areas are cleaned.  
Ensure establishment is maintained clutter free and organized.
