POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance	<i>Violation Description:</i> All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c)) <i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed excessive dust build-up on fanguards in walk-in cooler. Clean/maintain fanguards to prevent possible overhead contamination.

All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. Clean/maintain.

(114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172) <i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed in-use rice scoop stored in dirty standing water container. Ensure in-use rice scoops are stored in ice water. Corrected on site.
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40: Wiping cloths: properly used and stored

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance	<i>Violation Description:</i> Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135) <i>Inspector Comments:</i> Observed low quat sanitizer level at 0 ppm in sanitizer bucket. Ensure sanitizer level is maintained between 200 ppm - 300 ppm for quat. Corrected on site.
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48: Food Worker Certification

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance	<i>Violation Description:</i> This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
