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6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Provide a splash guard minimally 6" high or provide a separation of 24" between drainboard of 3 compartment sink and handwash sink to prevent contamination of clean and sanitized utensils. Observed clean and sanitized utensils on drainboard next to hand wash sink. Provide paper towels from dispenser at handwash sink. Observed none.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Maintain cold holding temperatures of potentially hazardous foods at or below 41 degrees. Observed temperature of container of bean sprouts measuring 57 degrees stored on prep table Placed back into refrigerator.

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Maintain used wiping towels in sanitizer solution between uses. Observed damp wiping towels stored on prep table.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Provide approved, cleanable mats on floors. Observed flattened cardboard used for mats in prep area. Discontinue.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
