RECLINER MUST BE REMOVED FROM FACILITY.
Sleeping items and sleeping is NOT permitted in a food facility.

Observed a suit case under a serving table with a large, red, white and blue crocheted blanket in it. Bartender stated that blanket, called an afghan, was made for the club and that it is stored here until its auctioned off.
REMOVE suitcase and blanket from dining area.

Sleeping/living quarters are not permitted in a food facility.
REMOVE ITEMS IMMEDIATELY.
