
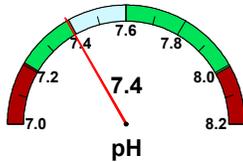

Inspector Comments: Ensure the spa pump is in operation when spa is open for use. Observed spa pump not operating. Corrected on site. Operator turned on spa pump.

Violation Description: Each pool shall be provided with a separate recirculation system designed for the continuous recirculation, filtration and disinfection of the pool water. The pumps, filters and all related parts of the pool water purification system shall be kept in operation whenever the pool is available for use.

Overall Inspection Comments

The following signs will be required by next year

- An illustrated diagram with text at least 1/4 inch high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures
- The emergency telephone number 911, the number of the nearest emergency services and the name and street address of the pool facility.
- A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP CLOSED."
- A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
