



Violation Description: Every person operating or maintaining a public swimming pool must do so in a sanitary, healthful and safe manner. Unhealthful, unsafe or unsanitary conditions include, but are not limited to, the failure to meet clarity, disinfection, pH, safety or bacteriological standards, broken glass on pool deck, electrical hazard; chemical storage.

All dry-niche light fixtures, and all underwater wet-niche light fixtures operating at more than 15 volts in public swimming pools shall be protected by a ground-fault circuit interrupter in the branch circuit, and all light fixtures in public swimming pools shall have encapsulated terminals. The ground-fault circuit interrupter shall comply with Underwriter's Laboratory standards.

36K444 Equipment - Recirculation Pump/Filter/Separation Tank

Violation Description: Each pool shall be provided with a separate recirculation system designed for the continuous recirculation, filtration and disinfection of the pool water. The pumps, filters and all related parts of the pool water purification system shall be kept in operation whenever the pool is available for use. All parts of the pool and related pool facilities and equipment shall be maintained in good repair.

The backwash from a diatomaceous earth filter shall discharge into a separation tank. The wastewater from the separation tank shall discharge into a sanitary sewer or other disposal system acceptable to the local wastewater agency.

The direction of flow for the recirculation equipment shall be labeled clearly with directional symbols such as arrows on all piping in the equipment area.

36K460 Skimmers - Requirements

Violation Description: The pool shall be equipped with one or more skimming methods to provide continuous skimming of the pool water and shall be capable of continually withdrawing not less than 75 percent of the required flow rate. Skimmers and water levels shall be maintained and operated to remove floating scum, sputum or debris continuously. The skimmer shall be recessed into the pool wall, individually adjustable for the rate of flow with either an external or internal device, provided with an air lock protective device and provided with a removable and cleanable screen or basket to trap objects.

Violation Description: Effective September 2012, sign requirements changed. This is not a violation at this time but shall be corrected prior to the 2014 pool season. Failure to comply may result in a violation. The new sign requirements are as follows:

All signs shall have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches high, unless otherwise required, affixed to a wall, pole, gate or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all pool users. The following shall be posted:

- a) Maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool.
- b) "NO DIVING" at pools with a maximum water depth of 6 feet or less.
- c) Where no lifeguard service is provided, a warning sign shall be posted stating, "WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY." The sign also shall state in letters at least 1 inch high, "Children under the age of 14 shall not use pool without a parent or adult guardian in attendance."
- d) An illustrated diagram with text at least 1/4 inch high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures.
- e) The emergency telephone number 911, the number of the nearest emergency services and the name and street address of the pool facility.
- f) A warning sign for spa pools with "CAUTION" language.
- g) Where pools were constructed for which lighting was not required, a sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s) stating, "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK."
- h) A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP CLOSED."
- i) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- j) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high shall be posted that describes the requirements for wave pools.
- k) A sign shall be posted at each spray ground and be visible from any part of the spray ground that states, "CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED. DO NOT DRINK."

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REQUIRED SIGNS FOR POOLS

All signs must be posted in a location visible to all pool users.

1. "WARNING - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY"

- Required at all spas where lifeguard service is not provided.
- Letters must be at least 4" high.
- Sign must be located in plain view of persons entering the spa area.
- The sign also shall state in letters at least 1 inch (25 mm) high, "Children under the age of 14 shall not use pool without a parent or adult guardian in attendance."

2. ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION AND CPR

- Sign must have illustrated diagrams with artificial respiration and CPR procedures.
- Text at least ¼ inch high
- Sign must be posted within the spa enclosure and be clearly visible.

3. EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBERS

- Shall have "911" number.
- Shall include the number of the nearest emergency services.
- Shall include the name and street address of the pool facility shall be posted.
- Letters shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high.

4. OCCUPANCY LOAD

- Must have clearly legible letter/numerals not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high.
- Shall indicate the maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool.
- The pool user capacity for all pools (except spas) shall be based on one pool user for every 20 square feet (1.858 m2) of pool water surface area.

5. "NO DIVING"

- Signs shall be posted in conspicuous places and shall state, "NO DIVING" at pools with a maximum water depth of 6 feet or less.
- Letters shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high.

6. "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK"

- Where pools were constructed for which lighting was not required, a sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s).
- Letters shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high.

7. "KEEP CLOSED"

- A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area.
- Letters shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) high.

8. "Diarrhea"

- A sign in a language or diagram that states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- Letters shall be at least 1 inch (25 mm) high.
- It shall be posted in a location visible to entrance area.

- Ensure all pump equipment has the directional flow of water.
