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5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed employee wiping her hands in a cloth towel . Employee need to wash their hands properly and dry with a paper towel.
	Complied on 6/7/2013	

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

9. PROPER COOLING METHODS **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Measured cooked beans @ 44-48 F in 5 inches deep containers , cooked a day earlier and wasn't cooled properly . See VC & D.
	Complied on 6/7/2013	

Violation Description: All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed lack of knowledge regarding proper cooking temperatures as employee stated cooking temperature for 9pork, beef, chicken , fish) @ 145 F and reheating temperature 145 F.

Violation Description: All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. (113947-113947.1)

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed paper towels on top of dispenser. Place paper towels in the dispenser at all times.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

25. PERSONAL CLEANLINESS AND HAIR RESTRAINTS

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed employee cooking without hair restraint . Corrected during inspection.

Violation Description: All employees preparing, serving or handling food or utensils shall wear clean, washable outer garments or uniforms and shall wear a hairnet, cap, or other suitable covering to confine hair. (113969, 113971)



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33. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Owner need to replace rusted shelves in the walk in cooler and provide easily cleanable ones. Thoroughly clean all storage shelves from debris build up.

Violation Description: All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Thoroughly clean and sanitize the soda dispenser nozzles from mold and debris build up. Thoroughly clean the fan guards in the walk in cooler from dust build up.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Thoroughly clean the hood and filters from grease build up and close the air gap between the filters.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Measured NO sanitizer in the sanitizer in the sanitizer bucket . Maintain sanitizer (chlorine) concentration between 100-200 ppm.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

52. VC & D

POINTS 0	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Discarded beans in the trash in the kitchen of the facility holding @ 44-48 F in the walk in cooler , cooked a day earlier and wasn't cooled properly .

Violation Description: Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.
