



**Inspector Comments:** A complaint was submitted to the DEHS stating that the facility opened their pool after being closed by the health department. Observed pool opened at time of inspection. Facility management stated that they had been managing the facility for three weeks and was not aware that the pool was closed by the health department. Ensure to keep pool closed until reopened by the health department. Reopening the pool/spa could result in a Hearing and possible permanent closure of pool/spa. Observed 0ppm disinfectant in pool/spa. Observed water level low. Observed no life ring, body hook, test kit, pool records, or safety signs. Pool/spa observed not functioning. Observed spa shut of valve not properly functioning. Pool/Spa is to remain closed until the violations are corrected. Pool/spa poses a immediate health risk to the public and can not be reopened until approved by DEHS. Sufficient evidence was observed to support the claim at time of inspection.
