POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed a hose stored inside the hand sink. Discontinue this practice. Keep all hand sink clear and accessible at all times for the purpose of handwashing ONLY.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)
