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7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

Inspector Comments: Measured butter and cut peaches stored inside the reach in cooler across from the cake display with temperatures ranging from 57F - 58F. Operator voluntarily discarded foods. See VC & D.

Discontinue holding all potentially hazardous foods at unapproved temperatures.

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE

Inspector Comments: Observed employee rinsed towel at the hand sink. Discontinue this practice. Keep all hand sink clear and accessible at all times for the purpose of handwashing ONLY.

Observed no available paper towels inside the dispenser at the hand sink near the 3-compartment sink. Provide adequate supplies of single use paper towels at all hand sinks at all times.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

23. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS

Inspector Comments: Observed 4-5 flies near the grill area in the back. Eliminate all flies/pests using an approved method.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Inspector Comments: Observed the splashing of soiled water from washing the floor onto a pallet of flour stored in the middle of the kitchen. Provide adequate storing space for all foods, protect food from all potential contaminations at all times.

Observed an opened bag of flour stored on top of the flour pallet. Stored all foods in a container with a secured, fitted lid at all times.

Violation Description: Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE

Inspector Comments: Discontinue the storing of soiled and clean equipments together. Provide separate storing space for each.

Observed the use of bowl as the scooping method for bulk foods. Provide an approved scooping method for all bulk foods, ensure to keep the scoop handle away from or outside of all food contact surfaces.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)



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38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Close several gaps at the filters on the hood above the grill.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

39. THERMOMETERS PROVIDED AND ACCURATE

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Provide a working thermometer to the reach in cooler across from the bakery display unit.

Violation Description: An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)

44. PREMISES; PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed employee's handbag stored at the preparation counter along with food equipments. Discontinue this practice. Provide adequate storing space for all employees' personal items.

Observed insect elimination device located over food preparation counters. Relocate device away from food and food preparation area.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Replace the damage floor near the bread ovens.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

Violation Description: Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.
