


Inspector Comments: Observed pool shell with cracks and chipping. Ensure to re-plaster pool shell. Pool and spa shell shall be in good condition, clean and well maintained. The pool shell must be white in color; free of any projections and designs. Spa shell may have a light pastel color.

Violation Description: The finished pool shell shall be lined with a smooth waterproof interior finish that will withstand repeated brushing, scrubbing, and cleaning procedures. The finish color shall be white. Tiles installed at the waterline shall be of contrasting color. A spa pool may be finished in a light color other than white when approved by the enforcing agent. Pool shell shall be maintained in good repair.

POINTS NA	Compliance Date: Not Specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - CCR 24 - 3120B	Inspector Comments: Observed the following missing signs: KEEP CLOSED - A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP CLOSED" (3120B.10). DIARRHEA - A sign in letters at least 1 inch (25 mm) high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water (3120B.11). <u>Ensure to install signs on the outside of the gate.</u>

Violation Description: Effective September 2012, sign requirements changed. This is not a violation at this time but shall be corrected prior to the 2014 pool season. Failure to comply may result in a violation. The new sign requirements are as follows:

All signs shall have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches high, unless otherwise required, affixed to a wall, pole, gate or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all pool users. The following shall be posted:

- a) Maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool.
- b) "NO DIVING" at pools with a maximum water depth of 6 feet or less.
- c) Where no lifeguard service is provided, a warning sign shall be posted stating, "WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY." The sign also shall state in letters at least 1 inch high, "Children under the age of 14 shall not use pool without a parent or adult guardian in attendance."
- d) An illustrated diagram with text at least 1/4 inch high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures.
- e) The emergency telephone number 911, the number of the nearest emergency services and the name and street address of the pool facility.
- f) A warning sign for spa pools with "CAUTION" language.
- g) Where pools were constructed for which lighting was not required, a sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s) stating, "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK."
- h) A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP CLOSED."
- i) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- j) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high shall be posted that describes the requirements for wave pools.
- k) A sign shall be posted at each spray ground and be visible from any part of the spray ground that states, "CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED. DO NOT DRINK."
