Overall Inspection Comments

This is a second re-inspection and it is to verify correction of the following violations.

1. Lack of IPCP
2. Aftercare form missing signs and symptoms of infection, including, but not limited to, redness, swelling, tenderness of the procedure site, red streaks going from the procedure site towards the heart, elevated body temperature, or purulent drainage from the procedure site and signs and symptoms that indicate the need to seek medical care.
3. Medical questionnaire missing questions regarding whether the client may be pregnant and whether the client has a history of medication use or is currently using medication, including being prescribed antibiotics prior to dental or surgical procedures.
4. Having one body art practitioner, Jay Pillos, providing body art services without being registered with San Bernardino County. Jay Pillos was ordered to cease and desist providing services during inspection. Jay Pillos shall comply with AB 300 before providing body art services in San Bernardino County.

All violations have been corrected. However, the IPCP needs to be completed. Observed IPCP no describing the procedure for decontaminating, sterilizing, and storing reusable instruments; set up and tear down of work stations; and prevention of cross contamination. Also, more description is needed in most of the IPCP sections.

This facility is scheduled for a third- re-inspection on or after 08-08-13 due to incomplete IPCP. Failure to correct violation on or before 08-08-13 will result in legal action taken.
