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4. PROPER EATING, TASTING, DRINKING OR TOBACCO USE

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed open cup of employees' drinks stored over the preparation line. Discontinue this practice. Provide adequate space for all employees' personal foods/drinks; separate away from all foods serving to the public.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Employees shall not eat, drink, or use tobacco in non-designated areas where contamination may result. (113977) An employee shall not use a utensil to taste food more than once without being properly washed, rinsed and sanitized between uses. (113976)

6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed a push cart stored directly in front of the hand sink near the entrance door. Keep all areas around the hand sink clear and accessible at all times for the purpose of handwashing.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Measured a bag of pepperoni inside the 3-door refrigerator with temperature ranging from 47F - 49F. Operator stated food was just out of temperature for about 30 minutes. Operator immediately relocated food to the freezer. Discontinue holding potentially hazardous food at unapproved temperatures.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

30. FOOD STORAGE; FOOD STORAGE CONTAINERS IDENTIFIED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed open bag of bulk foods stored on the rack without a container. Provide an approved storing method for all open bulk foods; with a secured, fitted lid.

Violation Description: Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

33. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed old food debris in between the gaskets of the refrigerators. Clean and maintain.

Violation Description: All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed ice machine with heavy debris build up. Clean and maintain the ice machine free of debris at all times.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)



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45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Clean and maintain the floor area near the ice machine and the fryers, as observed with heavy old food debris.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
