Inspector Comments:
-A follow-up inspection was conducted at facility regarding two food worker cards that have not been submitted to Division of Environmental Health Services (DEHS) within 14 days of the most recent inspection, conducted on 08/01/13.

-Upon inspection, operator stated that two food worker cards have not been obtained by two employees. Facility has seven days to submit food worker cards to DEHS. Non-compliance will result in future charged inspections at \$245.00 per hour.

Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
