The customer also stated that they have purchased fresh cheese that has a bad sour taste, and that the facility sells meat containing mosquitoes and mosquitoes feces.

Inspector Comments: Observed 2 slices of cheese discolored (grey in condition). Maintain food in good condition. See VC&D.

Violation Description: All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. Inspector Comments: 2 slices of cheese

Violation Description: Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.

Overall Inspection Comments

Observed tortillas for sale in good condition. Manager stated that some tortillas are made on site and others are shipped from their wholesale facility. Did not observe an expiration date but packages did contain a sell by date. Also observed a statement on packages stating that tortillas must be refrigerated once bought and taken home. Manager stated that tortillas are usually sold within 2 days.

Observed approximately 5 flies in meat/deli area. Did not observe any flies/mosquitoes or debris on chicken or any other meat inside the meat case. Did observe 1 dead fly inside of meat case. Observed missing grey lining on multiple sliding doors on meat case, causing there to be openings to the meat case. Did not observe any insects or debris on shrimp or seafood. Observed that seafood is not fully enclosed, but that there is a splash guard to protect the seafood from possible consumer contamination.

Observed cheese stored in display case at 40F. Observed two slices of cheese that were discolored (grayish) and no longer in good condition. See VC&D. Did not observe any sour smell on cheese.
