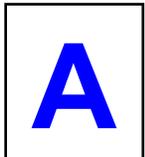

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7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure potentially hazardous foods are at 41F or below or 135F or above. Observed milk with an internal temperature of 49F, bolony at 49F and string cheese with an internal temperature of 50F in the walk in cooler. Observed walk in cooler thermometer at 48F. Operator states walk in cooler is time for defrost mode. Observed walk in cooler surface temperature drop to 45F and set to 40F.

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure to provide paper towels in the hand wash sink in restroom. Observed none.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure to chain pressurized cylinder to a rigid structure. Observed one unchained cylinder by mop sink.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure to provide missing light bulb in walk in cooler. Observed missing light bulb in walk in cooler.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)
