Wash utensils with warm soap water (minimum 100F), rinse, sanitize, and then air-dry. The employee was notified and utensils were washed with soap water at 102F, rinsed, sanitized and air-dried.  Chlorine sanitizer observed less than 50ppm in the sanitizer bucket. Maintain the chlorine sanitizer between 100-200ppm.
