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5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed employees changing from non food handling duties to food handling duties without first washing hands. Always wash hands when switching from non food handling duties back to food handling.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

9. PROPER COOLING METHODS **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed cooked chicken holding in the refrigerator at 57 degrees. Cook stated that the chicken was placed in the refrigerator the night before. Observed a large tub of steamed rice on a shelf underneath the rice cooker in the kitchen holding at 68 degrees. Cook stated that the rice was left on the shelving to cool over night. Follow proper cooling procedures as described in the violation description below.
	Not In Compliance	

Violation Description: All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.
