POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: -Observed missing hand paper towel in dispenser at handwash sink, next to fryer. Ensure handwash sink is supplied with hand paper towels in dispenser at all times for proper handwash. Corrected on site. -Observed dirty scrubber in handwash sink, next to three compartment sink. Ensure handwash sink is clear and accessible at all times for proper handwash. Corrected on site. -Observed excessive old food stains inside handwash sink, next to three compartment sink. Clean/maintain. Corrected on site.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: -Observed no hot water at handwash sink in men/women's restroom at customer area. Provide hot water to at least 100°F at handwash sink for proper handwash in men/women's restroom. NOTE: -Will return in 3-4 days to follow-up on hot water in men/women's restroom at handwash sink. Ensure hot water is provided to both restroom. Non-compliance will result in future charged inspections at \$245.00 per hour.

Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044).
