

Owner was instructed by mechanic to defrost refrigerator overnight due to excessive ice build up on condenser. Majority of food was left in refrigerator overnight. Observed walk-in temperatures ranging from 58-63 F. Facility has been closed due to improper holding temperatures in walk-in cooler.

Posted closure notice at door.

DO NOT HIDE, REMOVE OR RELOCATE or else FINES and LEGAL ACTION may be taken.

As soon as walk-in cooler temperatures have maintained below 40 F for approximately 1 hour, call inspector for re-inspection of walk-in cooler and opening. Re-inspection will be charged at \$122.50 per 30 minutes that re-inspection takes place.

DO NOT CONDUCT ANY FOOD RELATED BUSINESS UNTIL INSPECTOR RETURNS FOR RE-INSPECTION.
