Inspector Comments: Complaint received by EHS stated that food facility has taco cart on weekends in front of food facility.

Violation Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

Overall Inspection Comments

Observed taco cart stored on side of facility, locked away in dumpster area. Facility operator stated that the business had put out a taco cart on weekends to both attract more business and please their current customers. An official from the City had seen the cart and asked the business to stop, thus the cart was stored away. Facility made arrangements to have the taco cart removed from facility; cart was picked up during routine inspection.

Facility is currently not permitted to have a food cart outside of food facility at any time. If facility were to continue with cart, facility would risk having their health permit revoked due to operating outside of the permissions that the permit allows.

Steps to possibly have a hot food truck/cart outside of food facility:

Contact the City of Fontana to ask permission for allowing a hot food truck/cart to operate within their borders. City has the final say as to whether it's allowed and if the food cart can be stationary or roaming.

Contact County of San Bernardino Plan Check to get specifications/requirements for cart. Initial and final inspections as well as approval of cart will be performed by Plan Check.

Apply for valid health permit for a hot food cart with County of San Bernardino Department of Environmental Health.
