POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure employee are aware of assigned duties. Observed employees not aware of cooking temperature for ground beef and hot holding temperature. Cook ground beef to a minimum internal temperature of 155F for 15 seconds. Maintain potentially hazardous foods at minimum hot holding temperature of 135F. Left cooking and hot holding stickers.

Violation Description: All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. (113947-113947.1)

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Store boxes of frozen fries six inches above the floor. Observed boxes of fries on floor of walk in freezer.

Violation Description: Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Use quaternary ammonium test strips to verify sanitizer concentration is between 200-400 ppm. Observed bucket of quaternary ammonium in the cook line with concentration level below 200ppm.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

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48. FOOD WORKER CERTIFICATION

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure to obtain food worker card within 14 days and fax information to (909) 387-4272 or (909) 387-4323. Observed one employee without San Bernardino food worker card. A charged inspection will be conducted if information is not received by San Bernardino county Environmental Health Services within 14 days.

Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
