**Violation Description:** All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

**38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed light bulb nonfunctional in the reach in refrigerator in the cook line area, in the reach in in the bakery area, and under the hood in the cook line area. Replace light bulbs or repair fixtures.

**Violation Description:** Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed wiping towel on the cook line. Employee stated it was for cleaning the surfaces of te equipment. Store all wet or repeatedly used towels in a sanitizer solution or discard to laundry. Ensure sanitizer levels are maintained between 100ppm and 200ppm (chlorine) or between 200ppm and 300ppm (quatarnary ammonia).

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**Overall Inspection Comments**

"A" grade issued.

BHC law educated and hand out given.

Observed employee crack an eggs and change his glove without washing his hands. However he never came in contact food items. He only touched utensils. Recommend implementing a policy to wash hands and change gloves whenever an employee handles raw meat and eggs to avoid the risk of contamination.
