<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> - At 11:45, measured garlic in oil stored in a container on a cart in rear kitchen at 63 F. Per cook the food was placed on the cart at 10 am. Store this food at 41 F or below. Take small amount of food out of refrigerator as needed during cooking.  - Observed softened butter (room temperature) in teppanyaki area. Store this food at 45 F or below or use time as public health control.

**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed only one oyster tag. This facility has been open since December 22, 2013. This facility also serves mussels. Ensure to keep the tags on files for minimum 90 days. Keep the tags in original bags or container until the foods are used up.

**Violation Description:** Comply with Gulf Oyster warning seasonal requirements (Title 17 CA Code of Regulations 13675, Cal Code Section 113707).

**27. FOOD SEPARATED AND PROTECTED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed raw salmon, raw eggs, and raw shrimps above ready to eat foods in sushi station. Observed raw salmon above a container of soup and salad in walk-in cooler. Store all raw animal products above ready to eat foods.  Observed open containers of sliced lemons and chopped green onions in buffet line. Ensure to provide the lids (preferable the ones with hinges) or keep open foods under sneeze guards.

**Violation Description:** All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

**36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a bowl used as sugar scoop in gelato making area. Use approved scoop with handle. Store scoop with handle out of food.  Observed pressurized CO2 tank not secured to a rigid structure with chain. Ensure to use the available chain.

**Violation Description:** All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed many wiping cloths on counters in rear kitchen and front service area. Observed no sanitizer bucket set-up at the beginning of inspection. Ensure to prepare sanitizer solution in sanitizer buckets and store multi-use wiping cloths in sanitizer bucket between each use. Replace sanitizer solution as needed: when it is dirty and to maintain the right concentration.

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)



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**44. PREMISES; PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a cup of tea on a kitchen shelf above prep table. Observed several personal foods on food storage racks in walk-in coolers. Store all personal items in a designated place, away from foods and food contact surfaces.

**Violation Description:** The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

**48. FOOD WORKER CERTIFICATION**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed 12 missing and expired food handler cards. Only San Bernardino County food handler cards are valid. Fax the completed missing food handler cards to 909-387-4272 within 14 days to avoid a charged.

**Violation Description:** This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.

Ensure to thoroughly wash all equipments and food contact surfaces. Observed some food residue on dumping steamer.

Observed several unlabeled bulk food containers in tempura station in service line.  
 Observed several open bags of bulk foods in dry store room.  
 Store bulk foods in containers with tight fitting lids and label all the containers with contents.

Observed several unlabeled chemical-filled spray bottles throughout the facility.  
 Label all chemicals with contents.
