Inspector Comments: Complainant states that she bought baby octopus and when she brought it home, it smelled bad and rancid like it was rotten.

Complaint investigated.

Octopus and seafood case inspected.

Observed no rancid odors in both types of octopus sold.
Observed semi-frozen octopus.

Meat and seafood manager states that the octopus is sold semi-frozen and removes ice from the octopus at customer request. The octopus is not run under water. If the product is received that the manager believes is bad, the product is returned to the shipper and is not offered for sale. If a customer returns meat or seafood, they are given credit for the product and the returned item is discarded in the meat barrel.

Violation Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
